Mission

- To grant scholarships to support the high educational level of training and education of youth that are successful but destitute of financial means in fields of business, economy, and engineering,
- To assist education institutes (to establish professorships, to support research departments, to support investments such as training, conference, seminar, etc.) in the fields of business, economy, and engineering,
- To establish and operate education institutes in cooperation with other education institutes or alone in the fields of business, economy, and engineering,
- To create new education business models (example: innovation and leadership institute),
- To do, have others do research and broadcasts in the fields of business, economy, and engineering, and to support the said broadcasts and research,
- To support projects suitable to the vision and objectives of the foundation.



Scholarships

General Information

Deloitte Education Foundation grants scholarships to students receiving undergraduate and post graduate education within the territory or abroad.

The basic criteria sought in students to be granted a scholarship:

- To have shown success in the LYS or ALES exams each year above the scores determined by Deloitte Education Foundation' Board of Directors
- Successful students currently studying at universities determined each year by the board of directors
- Students who are successful in competitions organized by Deloitte Education Foundation

Departments in which scholarships are to be granted in the undergraduate area:

- Industrial Engineering,
- Computer Engineering,
- Business Engineering,
- Business,
- Economy

Departments in which scholarships are to be granted in the post graduate area:

- MBA,
- Post Graduates in the Area of Business and Finance,
- Industrial Engineering and Industrial Engineering Programmes

Terms of Application

The following terms are required from students who are going to apply for Deloitte Education Foundation scholarships:

- Being a Turkish citizen
- Being loyal to Atatürk's Principles and Revolutions
- Having won or continuing to study the undergraduate/ post graduate programs of universities determined by Deloitte Education Foundation
- To need financial support according to assets and state of income, not to be working in any work earning income, not receiving any scholarship from private corporations other than those granted by universities and public corporations aside from any salary, fee from elsewhere
- Having a success rate of 3 out of 4 (or equivalent) over the mean grade of LYS base points to be determined annually by Deloitte Education Foundation for undergraduates
- Having a success rate of 3 out of 4 (or equivalent) over the mean grade of ALES base points to be determined annually by Deloitte Education Foundation for post graduates for new students, and 3.5 out of 4 (or equivalent) for intermediate classes

Application Process

Each year, the terms of application are announced on Deloitte Education Foundation's website following the announcement of LYS and ALES exam results. They are also announced to students through the scholarship offices of education institutes for which quotas are allocated.

Candidates shall make their applications to universities they are studying at for which quotas have been allocated with the Deloitte Education Foundation Application Form, and the additional documents requested.



Selection Process

- The Scholarship Committees formed by the universities which have been allocated quotas have preliminary interviews with the candidates, and determine 2 times as many scholarship candidates as the scholarship quota determined by Deloitte Education Foundation for its own schools that year, and they present the candidate assessment information to Deloitte Education Foundation.
- The candidates determined by universities have an assessment interview with the Deloitte Education Foundation Scholarship Committee.
- The results are notified to candidate after the interview.
- Deloitte Education Foundation scholarships continue for 12 months.
- Students who gain the scholarships are considered to have gained the scholarship for the remaining section of the normal period of the program in which they are enrolled. However, at the end of each term, Deloitte Education Foundation obtains the transcripts of students concerning the term, and examines whether they continue to fulfill the success criteria required for the continuance of scholarship.

Liabilities of the Scholarship

The scholarship holder is liable of complying with the rules and principles of the program, not providing any false and misleading information, completing the academic program he/she is enrolled in within the anticipated period, and submitting a certified copy of the certificate of completion stating the date of graduation as day/month/year to Deloitte Education Foundation.,

Scholarship holders are liable of submitting the information and documents requested by the foundation to the scholarship offices of relevant education institutes.

They are liable of not receiving scholarships in the form of cash aid from any institution, corporation, or person other than the schools and the Higher Education Credit and Dormitories Institution (HECDI).

The Continuation Process and Discontinuance of the Scholarship

Unless any determination is made concerning the "reasons for the discontinuance of the scholarship" mentioned below, the students who gain the right to a scholarship are not assessed again each year.

In order to continue scholarship, unless the scholarship holder has any acceptable rightful hindrance, he/she must not lose a term or grade or repeat the year, he/she must take all classes pertaining to the terms they are receiving education, and his/her average for the last term must not be any less than 3 out of 4 (or equivalent), any none of the reasons for discontinuance of the scholarship mentioned below must not have happened.

Events causing discontinuance of the scholarship are any of the following;

- Dropping below the term average for 2 consecutive terms or under 3 out of 4 (or equivalent) for a total of 3 times during the program,
- Being documented with a court decree that he/she is connected to illegal activities, or has committed a shameful crime,
- Has received disciplinary punishment,
- Not attending the trainings of the Deloitte Education Foundation
- Absenteeism to the courses
- Is determined to have made an untrue statement during his/her application,
- Not being able to complete the program within the normal education period,
- Having no more affair with school,
- Being detected to receive a scholarship from any institution other than schools or public corporations,
- Having a negative notification by his/her mentor based on rightful reasons
- Being part of income generating activities or long term internship without acquiring written approval from foundation's administration.

A scholarship holder whose term average drops below 3 shall be warned, and the terms for discontinuance of scholarship shall be reminded.

In the case the terms of discontinuance of scholarship take place in relation to the term average, the scholarship holder will be notified of the discontinuance of the scholarship, and the scholarship will be discontinued at the end of the current education year. In the case other terms for discontinuance of scholarship take place, the end of the year shall not be waited for the discontinuance of the scholarship.
